The Finance Act passed in 2000 has made it much simpler to make tax efficient donations to charities. All new donations only have to be supported by a Gift Aid Declaration as set out below. The Inland Revenue regard the rehearsal costs of a performing society as a charitable expense incurred by the society so they do not represent a tangible benefit to the individual members of the society. Therefore we can treat subscription payments from members as donations provided they are prepared to sign a Gift Aid Declaration.

If you pay tax (income or capital gains) please fill in the form below as this will increase the value of your subscription by 25%. If you do not pay tax but your partner/husband/wife/parent does, please get them to fill in the form on your behalf.

You can make a Gift Aid declaration to as many charities as you wish, as long as you pay enough tax to cover the reclaimable amount.
